- _____ Two (2) pair of old shoes (Always have an extra pair in case one gets wet).
- _____ Jacket, sweatshirt, or a long sleeve shirt.
- _____ Laundry Bag (Mesh bag with holes for ventilation).
- _____ Flashlight with at least one set of extra batteries.
- _____ One (1) towel and washcloth
- _____ Scout Handbook & Packet/Binder (Every Scout should carry theirs at all times!).
- _____ Notebook paper and pens/pencils.
- _____ Knife and Totin' Chip (If you do not have your Totin' Chip, do NOT bring a knife).
- _____ Scout Hat (Other hats are only permitted if decent and not with Class A).
- _____ Prayer Book and/or Bible
- _____ \$25.00 Spending money (\$50 Maximum, and must be given to Adult leader responsible for Scout's money on that trip).
- _____ Personal First Aid Kit
- _____ Matches and/or fire starters (Must be left in foot lockers unless being used under adult leader supervision / NO LIGHTERS!!).
- _____ Compass
- _____ Canteen
- _____ Portable alarm clock (Without radio)
